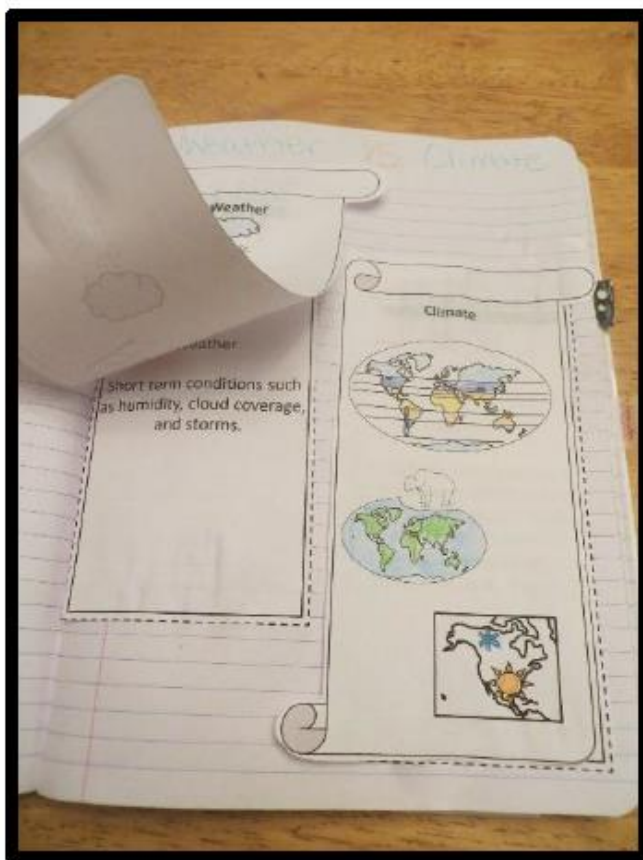


Interactive Notebook: Weather and Climate

1. Cut out all the weather and climate pieces. There are four in total: the weather pictures, climate pictures, weather definition, and climate definition.
2. Glue the weather definition and climate definition next to each other on the same page in your ISN.
3. Where it says "Glue here," glue ONLY the tip of the weather and climate pictures. Make sure the pictures match the definition beneath it. This will create a flap as shown below:



4. Color the pictures on the Weather and Climate flaps.
5. Once you have the pieces glued and colored, think about what type of climate you would prefer to live in, and what type of weather you might experience in that climate.
6. Once you have decided the type of climate you would like to live in, write and fill in the blanks for the following statements on the next page in your ISN:
